9. Scope of the Tender Price

The tender price shall include all costs associated with the performance of the contract. The tender price shall include all work, deliveries and fees necessary for proper and complete performance of the contract. The tender price shall also be set in consideration of price development in the given field, including the development of the Czech currency exchange rate against relevant foreign currencies until the completion of the contract.	
If the tender price, set in CZK (or EUR) excluding VAT, exceeds the maximum admissible amount, the Contracting Authority can cancel Tender because of economic reasons

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12. Evaluation of Tender

The basic evaluation criterion for awarding this public contract shall be the economic advantageousness of the tender – the tender price.

Based on the point value, the evaluation committee will rank the success level of individual tenderers, the most successful tender being the one that has received the lowest point score.

14. Conditions for the Submission of Tender

The Contracting Authority will not accept any variants of a tender.

The economic operator which has submitted a tender in the procurement procedure shall not be at the same time a person through which another economic operator proves qualification in the same procurement procedure.

15. Reserved Rights of the Contracting Authority

1. The Contracting Authority reserves the right to publish the notice of exclusion of a participant from the procurement procedure or the notice of selection of an economic operator on the Contracting Authority Profile. In that case, the notices shall be considered to be delivered to all participants at the moment of their publication.
2. The Contracting Authority reserves the right to retain all received tenders, duly delivered within the time limit for the submission of tenders.
3. The Contracting Party is entitled to cancel the procurement procedure without giving any reason.
4. The Contracting Authority shall not reimburse the economic operators for any costs associated with their participation in the procurement procedure.
5. In submitting the tender, the economic operator acknowledges that pursuant to Section 2 (e) of Act No. 320/2001 Coll., on Financial Audit in the Public Administration, as amended, the selected economic operator shall become a person liable to cooperate during financial audits. This obligation also applies to parts of tenders, contracts and related documents that are subject to protection pursuant to specific legal regulations (e.g. trade secrets and classified information), provided that the requirements stipulated by legal regulations (e.g. Act No. 255/2012 Coll., on Auditing, as amended) are complied with. The economic operator acknowledges that the selected economic operator will also be required to impose a similar obligation on its subcontractors.



6. The economic operator acknowledges that the Contracting Authority is obligated to comply with publicity requirements of the Structural Funds Programmes set out in Article 9 of Commission Regulation (EC) and OP RDE publicity rules applicable to all relevant documents related to the given procurement procedure or process, i.e. especially with respect to the award criteria, all contracts and any other documents related to the respective public contract.
